Overview of integration of 360 Link and COS Scholar Universe

The integration of COS Scholar Universe enhances 360 Link results pages with information provided by external repositories. Our exclusive partnership with **COS Scholar Universe** provides access to over 1.4 million profiles covering faculty members and researchers from academic and research institutions worldwide.

When you enable this functionality, patrons will be presented with “author” links within the citation’s results. If the link is selected, the patron will be presented with a new page displaying a limited version of the author’s Scholar Universe profile – or the author’s full profile if your library is a Scholar Universe subscriber.

Through our exclusive partnership with COS Scholar Universe we have arranged access for all 360 Link subscribers, even if you aren’t a COS Scholar Universe subscriber.

- Institutions that subscribe to COS Scholar Universe can provide patrons with “full profiles” for the cited author. These full profiles can include: name, contact information, affiliations, web pages, links to CVs, research interests, expertise, publications, grants, co-author information, associations/societies, honors/awards and previous affiliations.
- Institutions that don’t subscribe to COS Scholar Universe can receive access to a “free version” of Scholar Universe. This version is a scaled-down version of the full profile, and includes more detailed information on an author than is typically found in citations and within citation databases. Profiles may include a partial publication list from which users can link to verified co-authors or to possible co-authors. By activating this new enhancement, you will gain access to the free version - with no additional cost and no additional setup.

Activating COS Scholar Universe within 360 Link

Users can activate this new enhancement by navigating to the 360 Link Advanced Features section of the Client Center, where a “Scholar Universe Settings” link appears within the Customization Menu. You simply need to select the link to edit the settings, choose to Enable Scholar Universe Links and then save the changes.

You can now enable your patrons to link from the 360 Link results page to detailed information about books in print, including previews, tables of contents, and in some cases full copies of the books (where permission has been given or the book is in the public domain) available through Google Books.
